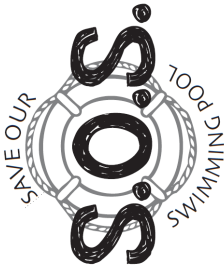

Mission: The mission of the Durand Swim Club is to serve the aquatic recreational, educational and health and wellness needs of Durand and the surrounding communities.



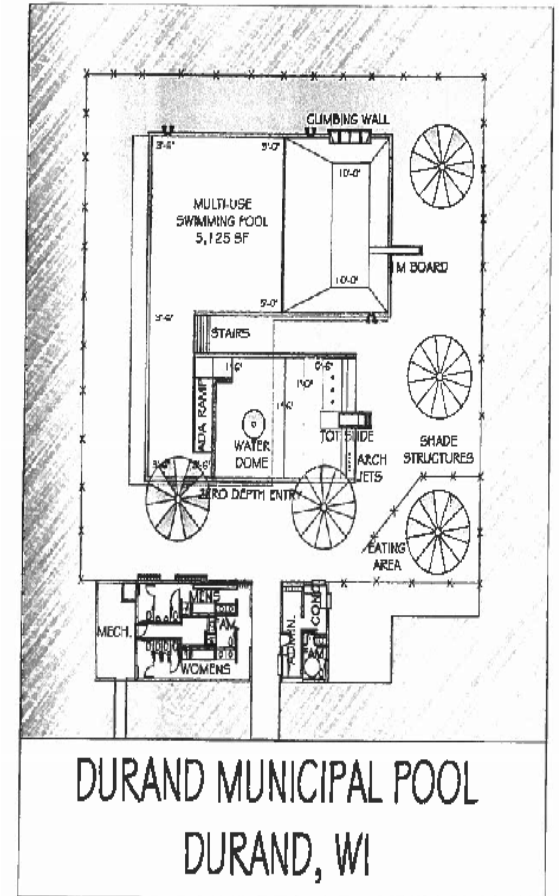
Pool History

- Durand had its first pool in 1952, a large hole lined with tar.
- In 1976, a more suitable pool was built by the City that has served the community since.
- 300 children each summer take swimming lessons in Durand,
- Many teens obtain their WSI certification along with securing a summer job.
- Many adults utilize the pool to better their health and well being.
- Due to water leakage, eroding plumbing, and other problems, it is necessary to either build a new pool, or renovate the current one.

What Does the Future Hold?

- The Durand Swim Club has been working closely with the Durand City Council in determining the best solution for the future of the pool.
- A design and consulting firm, USAquatics, was hired, and conducted a study on the needs of the pool and the community.
- It was determined the most beneficial and cost effective option was to renovate and improve the current pool and facilities, with an estimated cost of \$2.5 million.
